As Rhyl bounces back from the pandemic, it does so with more optimism than for many years. I have been working closely with the local community to outline how improvements to the seafront can be expanded upon, and importantly how much-needed regeneration can be brought to Rhyl town centre.

The UK Government's 'Levelling Up Fund' offers a fantastic opportunity to do this, but I am determined that investment made does not repeat mistakes of the past, and that regeneration is more than just cosmetic. Rhyl needs a town centre to once again be proud of.



Chancellor Rishi Sunak visited Marine Holiday Park in Rhyl to witness UK Government Covid-19 support packages in action and to discuss opportunities for the area post pandemic.

As with all areas, I have had a number of problems to address - including the maintenance of the Rhyl Cut, controversial planning applications, poorly thought-through town centre bollards, and antisocial behaviour at the Botanical Gardens. There are also many positive

developments I have been involved with, including the new Royal Alexandra Hospital, a new post-Covid Job Centre on Bodfor Street and early concepts for a marina.

The collapse of Rhyl FC last year was a hammer blow but I was pleased to support the club in its rebirth. They

now face the opportunity of securing their Belle Vue grounds for the future and I look forward to assisting them in obtaining the necessary financial backing needed to do this.

The Value of our Environment



The protection of our environment remains high on the national agenda, and I am keen to reflect that locally. Flooding in the area in recent years has been devastating for a number of residents and I continue to work to ensure that we are better protected in future. I am also doing what I can to prevent new housing developments being built on land which is susceptible to flooding.

I recently hosted a Vale of Clwyd Climate Summit, during which three expert panels engaged constructively with residents to consider how we can all behave in an environmentally-friendly way. Green energy opportunities for our region were also discussed – from tidal energy to hydrogen production, and carbon capture and storage. At Parliament, I am engaged with proposals to tackle air pollution and litter and to introduce a new deposit return scheme.

Animal welfare issues are receiving increasing attention and I have been pleased to support legislation to ensure animal abusers face tougher sentences.

What 'Levelling Up' means to the Vale



The Levelling Up agenda seeks to ensure that all parts of the UK have the resources they need to thrive. The UK Government is making tens of millions of pounds available within Denbighshire alone.

The 'Levelling Up Fund' is intended to deliver high-value regeneration projects and I am already in advanced conversations with local stakeholders to establish priorities.

I have been pleased to support dozens of organisations in applying for support through the UK Community Renewal Fund,

which is evolving to replace the former EU structural funds. The 'UK Community Ownership Fund' has also been launched. This allows local organisations to purchase at-risk facilities, such as sports grounds, pubs and corner shops.

The UK Government is making tens of millions of pounds available within Denbighshire alone.

At the Budget, Chancellor Rishi Sunak accelerated funding for the North Wales Growth Deal, bringing the prospect of new jobs and opportunities to the region. It is hoped that projects to be supported can include the redevelopment of the former North Wales Hospital in Denbigh, the expansion of high-tech engineering industries at St Asaph Business Park and town centre redevelopment at Rhyd.

I am keen to assist local companies to make the most of new trade deals emerging since Brexit and recently held the first of a number of Export Programme events.

Healthcare a priority beyond Covid-19



At the election, I pledged to work to bring NHS services in North Wales up to standard. At that point, none of us knew that existing challenges would be compounded by the largest health emergency in living memory. Despite the immense pressures that health and care staff have been under, they have worked tirelessly to protect us all. I have been proud to work with colleagues to deliver vaccines into arms locally, and thanks to our world-leading programme, we can now look beyond the pandemic to refocus on the challenges facing the local health board.

As a GP and member of the Commons Health & Social Care Select Committee, I have first-hand experience of how the healthcare system in North Wales is letting too many people down. My inbox is full of concerns from those who have suffered as a result. I am working with key individuals to see the

introduction of UK-wide comparable data on NHS performance and outcomes, and new mechanisms to ensure a minimum standard of care for all British citizens.

I am also pushing for equal access and choice to hospital services across the country, regardless of where in the UK we live. I want to use my position to level up the NHS, to ensure that all who need it can access the best care as soon as possible.

More police officers to tackle crime



Since the General Election, North Wales Police have recruited 147 new police officers as part of a national effort to boost numbers by 20,000.

North Wales Police and Denbighshire County Council were awarded £517,000 by the Home Office to roll out the 'Safer Streets' programme in west Rhyl. This has seen the delivery of hundreds of 'crime prevention packs' to residents and the installation of CCTV cameras. There is also a new community garden, a newly established Community Champions Group, and there are new digital locks on existing alley gates. These activities are helping create a safer environment and combat criminality such as shoplifting, burglary, vehicle crime, and robbery. They also assist tackling County Lines drugs supply. Recently, all five identified county lines drug telephones supplying in Rhyl were shut down and all 16 individuals concerned were arrested.
